FIRST EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION NUMBER 2022-61 ISSUED BY PROCLAMATION OF THE CHAIRMAN HURRICANE IAN

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2022, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 2022-219 (amending Executive Order Number 2022-218) declaring a state of emergency for all Florida counties due to Hurricane lan;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted in Chapter 30 of the County Code of Ordinances, on September 25, 2022, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County (the "Chairman") issued Emergency Declaration Number 2022-61 declaring a State of General Emergency due to Hurricane lan;

WHEREAS, the Chairman has been informed by County Emergency Management staff that conditions and damage from Hurricane Ian continue to require mitgation, response and/or recovery efforts; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 30 of the Code authorizes a state of emergency to be extended by proclamation of the Chairman when a quorum of the Board of County Commissioners is unable to meet.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CHAIRMAN HEREBY RESOLVES, FINDS AND DECLARES:

- 1. That the State of General Emergency is extended for a period of 7 days commencing at 8am on Monday, October 3, 2022.
- 2. In accordance with Section 252.46, Florida Statutes, this extension shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court and Ex Officio Clerk to the Board within 3 days after its issuance, and shall be posted on the County's designated website https://levydisaster.com.
