Levy County Deploys Resources to North Carolina For Hurricane Florence Support

On Tuesday, September 11, 2018, the State of North Carolina requested 5 ambulance resource teams to be deployed in preparation for Hurricane Florence.

As part of the Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC), Levy County is sending two ambulances with personnel to join crews from Escambia, Osceola, and Walton Counties to deploy to North Carolina to support the local resources already on scene.

Levy County is proud to do our part in making sure that we are able to assist the residents and visitors that are in the path of this dangerous and potentially deadly storm. Chief Mitch Harrell is proud of the dedication and hard work of his responders and knows that they will make Levy County proud.

These responders will be deployed for at least 7 days. Chief Harrell wants to assure the public that the request did not change the number of first responders and resources that will be responsible for calls for service in Levy County. Part time and full time responders will cover any shift shortages that would be needed to ensure the safety of Levy County residents. It will be a lot of work, but they are up to the challenge and ready to help.
