Hurricane Housing Recovery Program

The Hurricane Housing Recovery Program (HHRP) helps low-to moderate income homeowners recover from Hurricane Idalia. The HHRP has \$1.267 million allocated to rebuild or rehabilitate homes impacted from the storm or to reimburse homeowners who have already completed repairs.

Homeowners Must:

- 1. Own the damaged home.
- 2. Have experienced damage to the home from Hurricane Idalia.
- **3.** Use the home as their primary residence (Homestead).
- **4.** Maintain a mortgage in good standing or be on a payment plan in good standing.
- **5.** Be up to date on Property Taxes.
- **6.** Have a household income at or below 120% of Levy County's area median income (AMI). See chart below.

Homeowners Can Apply For:

Disaster Assistance: Up to \$15,000 (Must be for items in LHAP)

Owner Occupied Rehabilitation: Up to \$30,000

Demolition / Reconstruction: Up to \$170,000
